



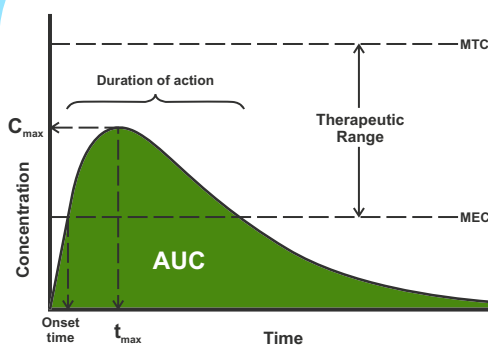

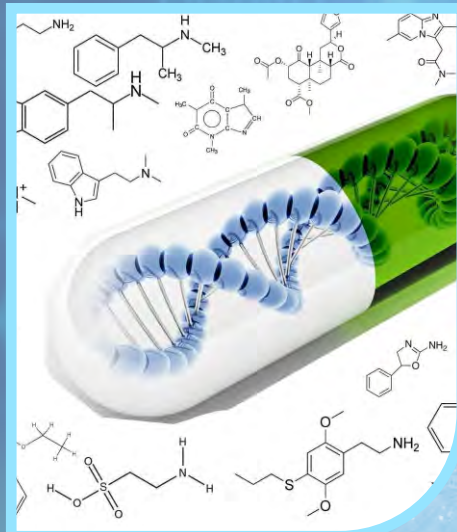

## In and Around Bangaluru

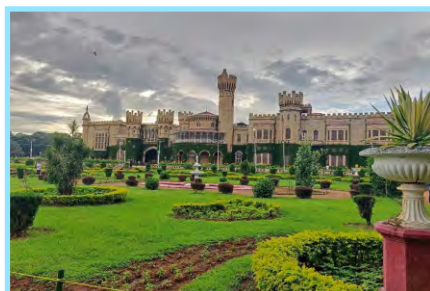


### Lalbagh Botanical Garden:
